The Angel: Gabriel

1) Faithful angels obey God

‘Your kingdom come., your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.’ *Matthew 6:10*

We should obey God as quickly and willingly as the angels of God obey Him

2) Angels announced the good news of salvation

The Recipient: Mary

1) She was a recipient of God's grace


'...you have found favor (grace) with God.'

2) She was a humble person

'Though the Lord is on high, he looks upon
the lowly, but the proud he knows from
afar.' *Psalms 138:6*

The Subject: Jesus Christ


Only Jesus can save you from your sin

1) His Name

2) His Nature: Human and Divine

Jesus was and is absolutely God (*John 10:30*)

3) His Greatness: He conquered death

The Subject: Jesus Christ

4) His Lordship

At His first coming, His earthly reign was rejected (*John 1:11, 19:15b, Luke 19:14*)

His heavenly reign must now be accepted (*Luke 17:21, Acts 2:36, Romans 10:9*)

He will come again to rule and reign on earth
