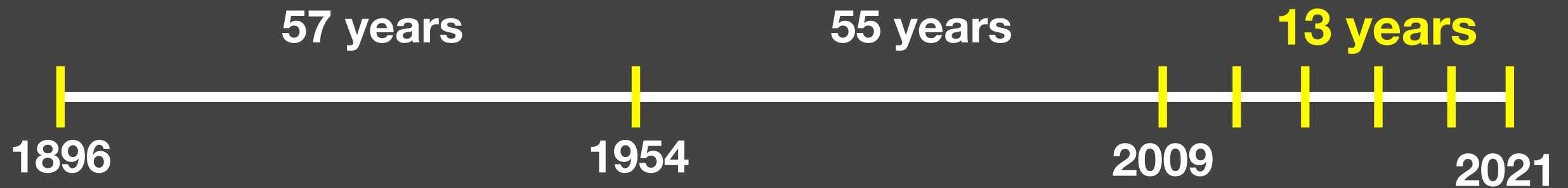

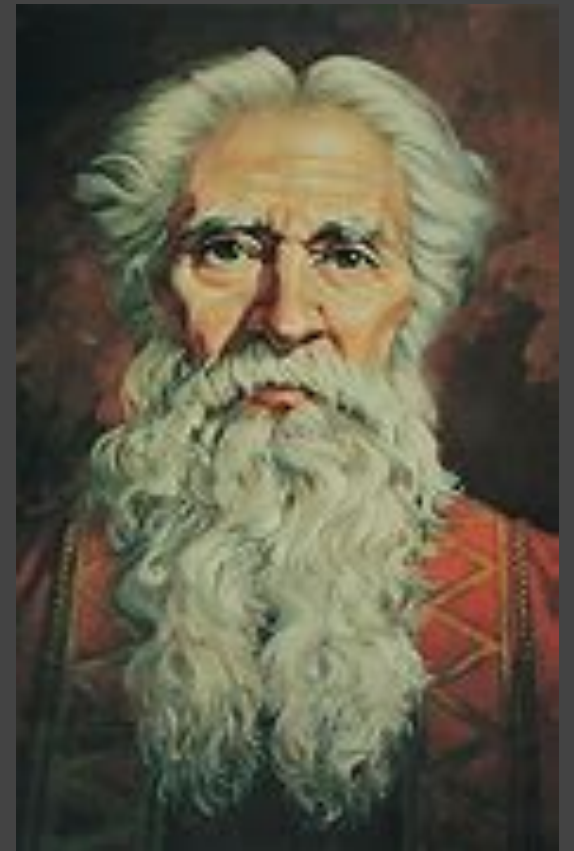

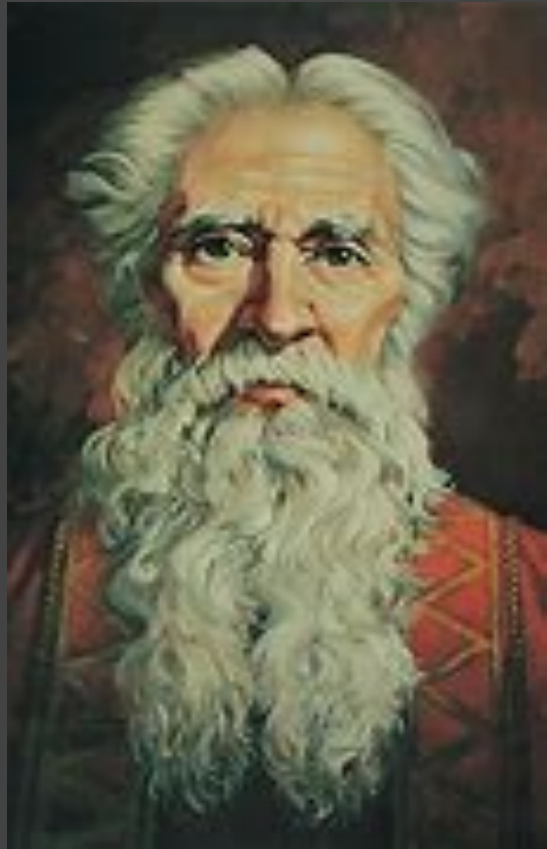

- **Jotham** - ruled 16 years, was a good king but the people were disobedient.
2 Kings 15:32-38; 2 Chron. 27:1-9
- **Ahaz** - ruled 16 years, was a bad king, he burned his son as an offering
2 Kings 16; 2 Chron. 28
- **Hezekiah** - ruled 29 years, was a good king but had pride issues.
2 Kings 18-20; 2 Chron. 29-32





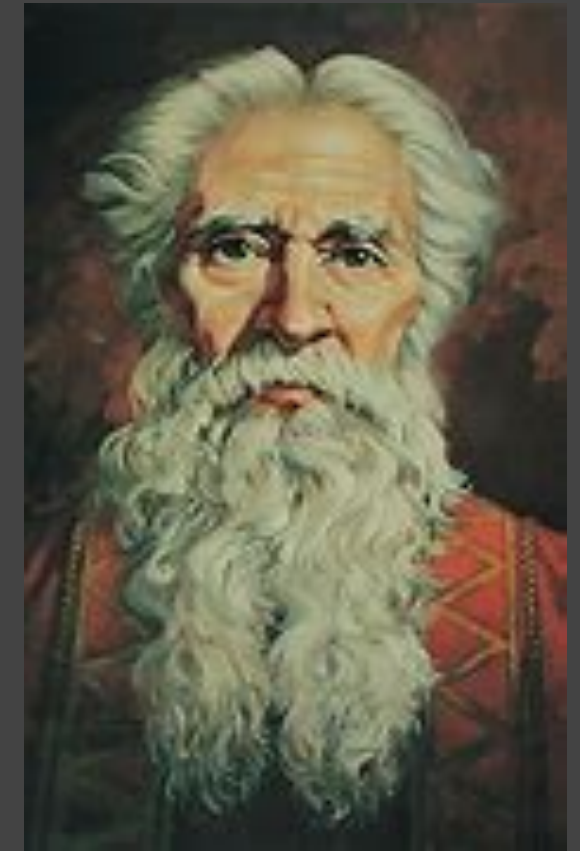

But this is the one to whom I will look; he who is humble and contrite of spirit and trembles at My word.

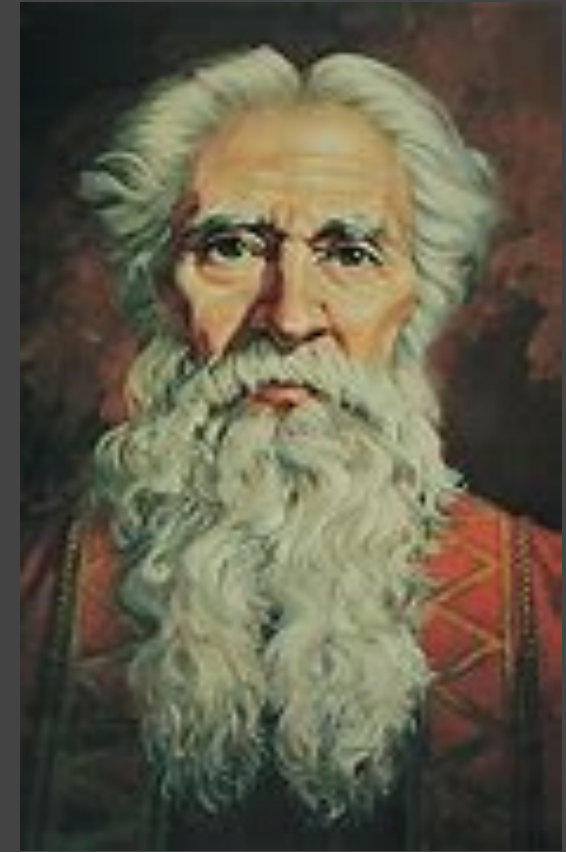
