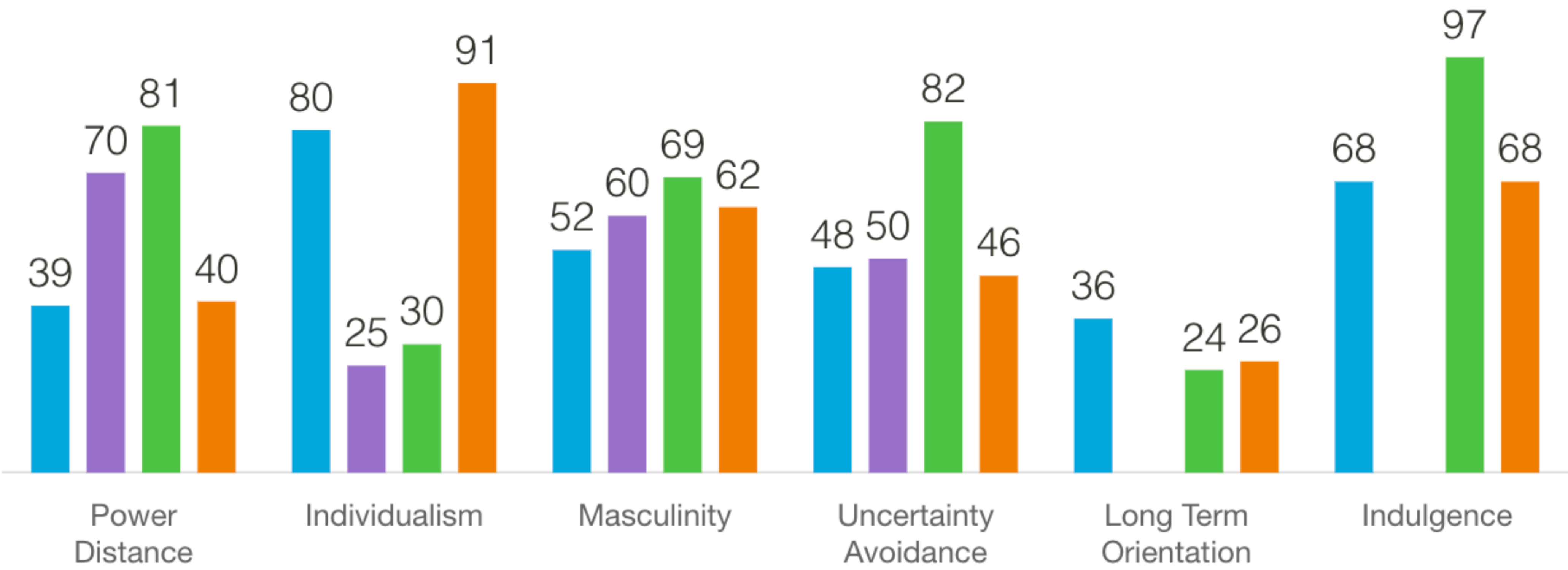
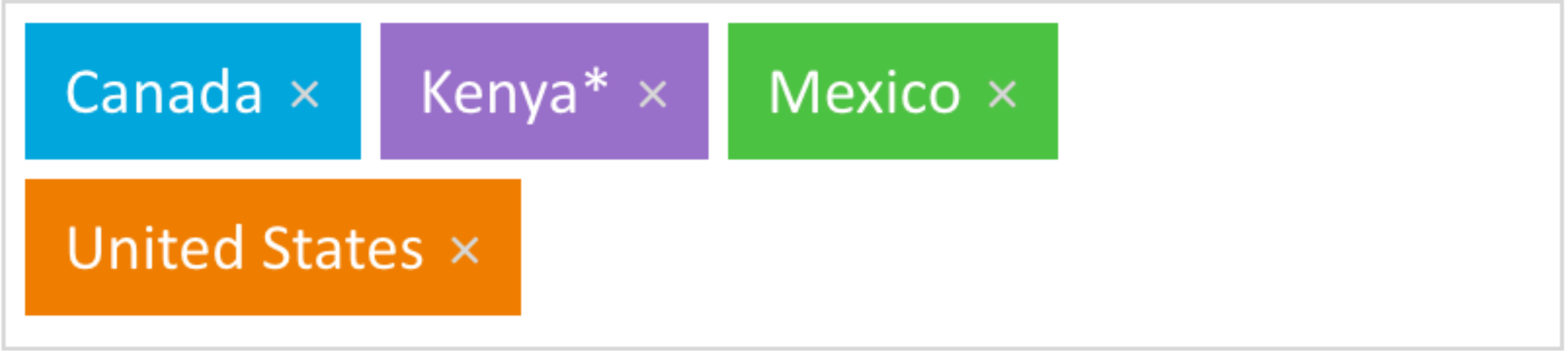

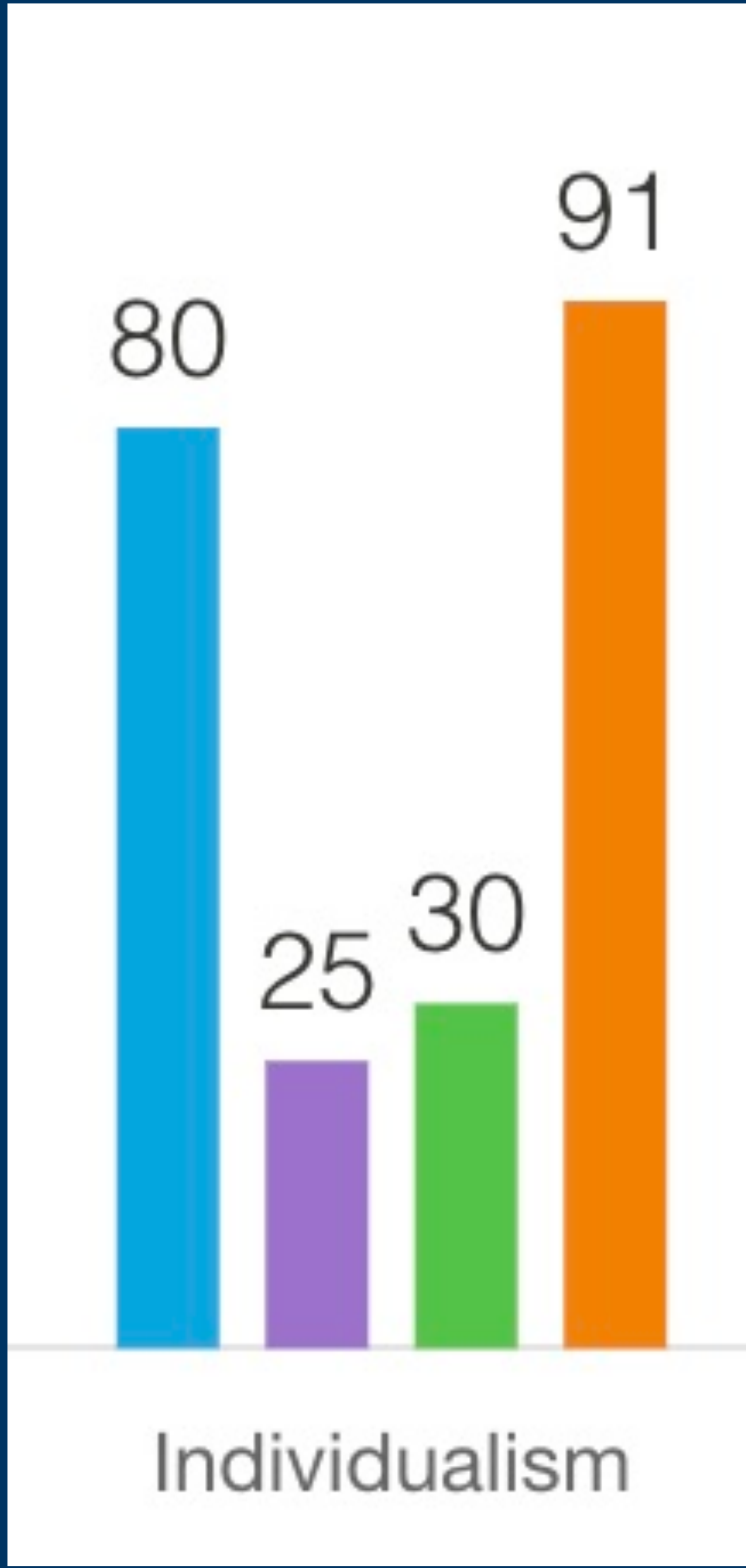
# The Spirit Gives Us Power
